CHURCH SIGN UNDERWAY SOON After some delay, we are finally ready to move ahead with our digital church sign project. After much research and advice, the size of our sign has increased a bit from our original plans (old: 6x3, new: 6x4). With this increase and some prep work that needs to be done to power the sign in a more optimal location, our fund is about \$13K short of being fully funded. While our general fund can make up that difference, our church leaders want to share an opportunity that has recently become available: A generous donor is willing to match any offerings for the sign, up to \$6.5K. Reaching this amount (6.5K), plus the matched gift (6.5K) would fully fund our sign project balance (\$13K). YOUTH CAMP UPDATE It's a few months before camp begins, but there are a few changes with camp this year so hopefully some early info is helpful. Camp will take place August 4-9. The camp is for children, ages 9-16. Those age 17 and older are invited to help as counselors and staff (parents serving as staff can bring along their younger children as junior campers). Camp will take place at <u>Dworshak</u> <u>State Park in Lenore, ID</u>. This is a change and a further distance than in recent years, but we hope to be able to assist with travel efforts.
